A world-first clinical trial of an advanced method of imaging spinal cord injury is now underway in Adelaide.

The study is open to anyone aged between 18 and 75 years (inclusive) who has sustained a spinal cord injury.

Regardless of the level, severity or time since your injury you may be eligible to participate.

Study visit dates and times are flexible and negotiable. The results of the medical imaging and assessments can be shared with your doctor to assist in your ongoing care. You will be reimbursed for all study-related travel costs.
