<sup>2</sup>NSW uses a mix of SNOMED, ICD-9-AM and ICD-10-AM coding over the years in emergency department encounters. All codes in emergency department encounters were mapped to ICD-10-AM codes. All codes mapped to the ICD-10-AM codes in this table were considered falls, except for SNOMED code was 129839007 ('at risk of falls') or 430576002 ('at risk of injury due to falls'), which were excluded and therefore not considered a fall.
