- Before the event: work in the office mailing out packages or staffing our incentive pick up desk prior to the event dates and times to suit you
- At the BRIGHT Walk: be available for a minimum four-hour shift on Saturday 22 July 2023 sometime between 3.30-9.30pm, as well as a briefing session beforehand (date and time TBC); Please note that for safety requirements, you need a mobile phone during the event.
- You must be respectful, energetic, punctual, reliable, and committed to ensuring a fun and safe event for everyone.
